

FREE disposal of Household Hazardous Waste at the Sudbury Landfill is available for any resident of Walla Walla County.

Keep dangerous chemicals away from children, pets, and the environment by bringing items to the HHW Facility for proper disposal.

Accepted Items Include:

- Used motor oil
- Antifreeze
- Solvents and cleaners
- Glues
- Fertilizers
- Pesticides
- Pool chemicals
- Batteries
- Fluorescent lights
- Paints (latex, oil, and spray types)
- Medical sharps from home use*



*Sharps must be in a sealed, leak and puncture-resistant container and clearly labeled. Empty laundry detergent or bleach bottles work well.



Place items in original or labeled and non-leaking sealed containers 5 gallons or less in size.

Items **NOT** Accepted:

- Ammunition or other explosives
- Asbestos
- Radioactive materials or medicines
- Propane tanks
- Smoke alarms
- Any items generated by a business[^]
