NOTICE OF CALL FOR BIDS**

The City of Walla Walla, Washington (herein called the "Owner") invites bids for the construction of 2019 Sewer Main Replacement Project (PWE NO. WW18001). Work includes sewer main replacement with alleys, sidewalk, curb and gutter, driveway, and asphalt paving.

Sealed bids plainly marked "**BID ENCLOSED – 2019 SEWER MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT**" will be received at the office of the City Clerk, 15 North 3rd Avenue, Walla Walla, WA, 99362, until **1:30 p.m.**, local time, **Thursday, June 27, 2019**, then publicly opened and read aloud. The Contractor is subject to all requirements related to State Prevailing Wage Rates, EEO, and Washington State Contracting Laws, etcetera. The Contract time for all work shall be **Forty-five (45) working days**.

Plans and specifications will be available starting **Thursday, June 6, 2019**. Informational copies of the plans and specifications are on file for inspection at the City of Walla Walla Engineering office, 55 E. Moore Street.

To become an eligible bidder on the proposed project, bidders must use QUESTCDN at <https://www.questcdn.com> and purchase a copy of the Contract Documents from the website for \$15. The Contract Documents are available under **eBidDoc #6386528**.

All bid proposals shall be accompanied by a bid deposit in cash, certified check, cashier's check, or surety bond in an amount equal to five percent (5%) of the amount of the bid. Only properly executed bids submitted on the form furnished by the City will be accepted. Award will be based on the total bid. The City Council reserves the right to accept or reject any or all bids or waive any defects therein.
